PROGRAM

EARLY STAGE ONE

Early Stage I is exploring what makes places special to us, and how we take care of these spaces. We have chosen places such as our homes, to explore in artwork. Inspired by reading Here We Are by Oliver Jeffers, we have created a stained-glass globe featuring special places across the world. The globe uses geographical mapping skills to represent that we are all connected. The Kindy Poetry Slam will be on Seesaw throughout the week and showcases NPS' youngest poets learning descriptive language.

STAGE ONE

Stage I explored the concept of community by learning about the connection we have to place. Our 'Pathways' theme this term focused on how our pathways connect us, and the importance of caring for Country. Drawing from the knowledge passed down to us by Uncle Jimmy Smith, we created artworks to express our love for country, featuring indigenous flora found in our special place - Newtown Public School. An informative safari around the school helped us discover living things in our own 'backyard'. Keep an eye out for our dioramas! Motivated by our learning around poetry and language, Stage I classes have each written an original verse in a collaborative rap about 'place'. Don't miss this being presented on Seesaw throughout the week.

STAGE TWO

Stage 2 have reflected on 'Connections' and investigated ways people connect with each other and the places they call home. In Geography, we drew native plants from the local area to represent their personal connection to the land. We also enjoyed creating paintings inspired by Wassily Kandinsky to represent the colours of the seasons. Everyone took inspiration from Frida Kahlo to paint self-portraits symbolising our individual and unique identity. Check out our 'Vivid Sydney' inspired prototypes we developed during our Science and Technology learning.

STAGE THREE

Stage 3 explored the question; "How do we connect to our place?" through poetry and Creative Arts. We wrote an original 'About Me' poem, using metaphor to represent our unique identities. Each poem is magically linked to a piece of music that we felt connected deeply to our personality - be ready to scan QR codes for the immersive experience! Inspired by The Encyclopedia of Ugly Animals, we each wrote our very own 'ode' to an ugly animal. We enjoyed crafting a rhyming, rhythmical poem written in stanzas, and recorded our spoken pieces – get ready for some Zoom poetry reading to celebrate this with us. We've also connected to our place through the medium of photography – go searching through the community for our wonderful works!
