Band – Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Euphonium, Bass Guitar, Glockenspiel, Percussion, Drums, Keyboard

Students who wish to participate in the band or one of the ensemble programs must be enrolled in private music lessons organized by their parents outside of school hours. A list of tutors is attached & also available at the school office.
