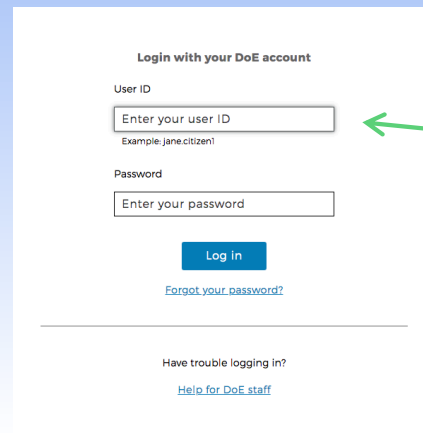
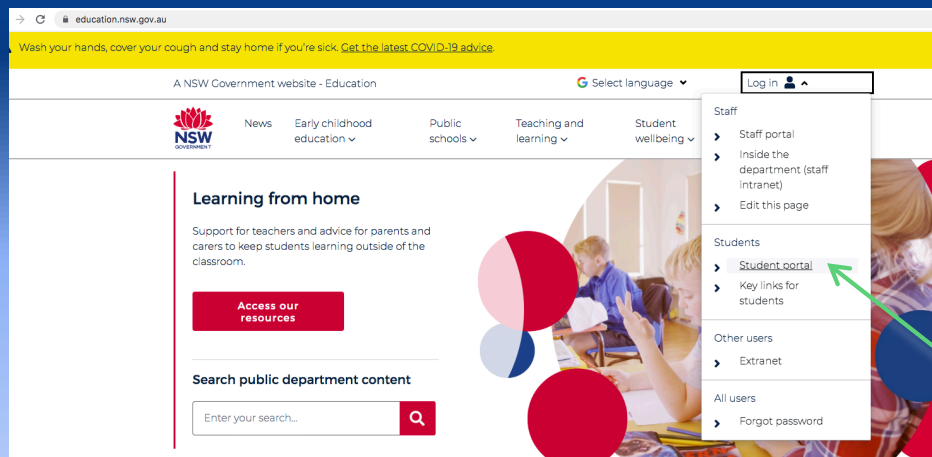

STUDENT LOG IN



- Go to www.education.nsw.gov.au
- Select STUDENT PORTAL on drop down selection
- Log in
 - USER ID = firstname.lastname e.g. abbey.proud1
 - PASSWORD = class password
 - Both are stuck inside the student's diary.

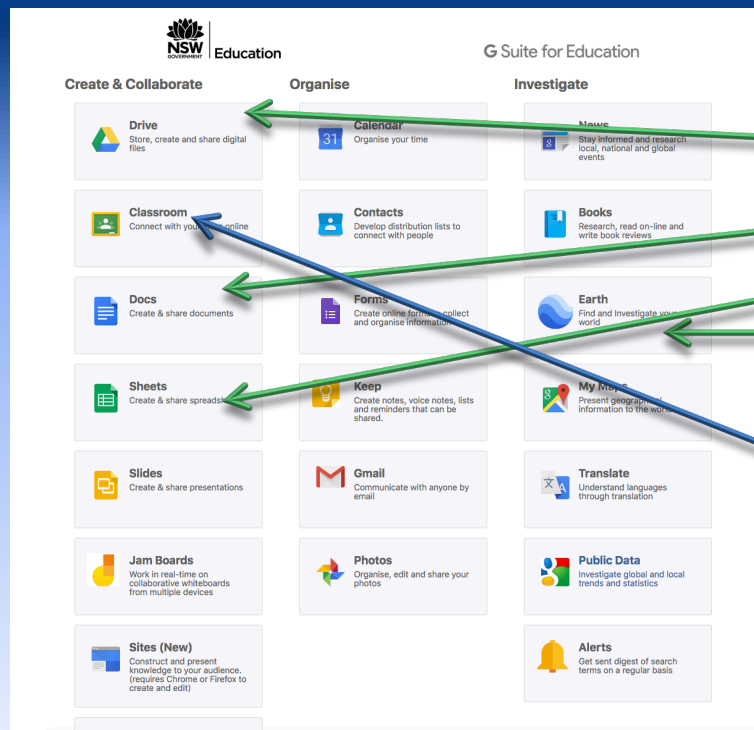
